

Stuff you need to bring:

1. Machine (including box, monitor, keyboard, mouse, joystick, necessary cables)
2. Headphones, no speakers will be allowed. Those with laptops will be asked to turn off external speakers.
3. Ethernet network card installed and working in machine.
4. Ethernet network cable. Nothing less than cat-5.
5. Power strip.

General Tips:

- * No smoking on the Ivy Tech campus.

- * No powered speakers or UPS systems.

- * The people associated with Ivy Tech are in no way liable for any lost, damaged, or stolen property.
- * NO CHEATING! This should really go without saying, but anyone caught cheating during a tournament will be removed from the Lan Party.
- * Please clean up after yourself. ("Hmmm... Trash in trash can... Makes sense.")
- * Ivy Tech does not permit nor condone any type of illegal activity. This activity includes, but is not limited to, the copying of illegal software and the distribution of pornographic material. Each machine is each person's own personal responsibility/liability

Party Rules:

Most LAN parties have rules that every attendee must follow. If everyone follows these simple rules, everyone will get along and there will be no conflicts.

1. You must be at least 16 Years of age or older to attend the party, and if you are under the age of 18, you need to bring a permission slip from your parents stating that they take responsibility for your actions.
2. There will be no smoking indoors, if you need to smoke, go outside to do so.
3. ADMIN's have every and all rights to deny or remove from the event anyone they deem necessary (period). If your not a jerk, and just get along, we can all have a great time!
4. Everyone has to sign the waiver stating that they take responsibility if anything happens to there person or there computer systems (subsystems). Which means anything you take into the event, you are liable for. (waivers are available at the event, and will state everything that is in this page.
5. No Alcohol allowed at all inside the Event Area, if you show up drunk, you will not be able to play. If you would like a drink, go up to the bar in the hotel and get one there, but please leave it there. If you have had too much to drink, I or any of the Admins that deem you unfit to play anymore will ask you to leave with no refund.
6. No Children Allowed during the Event! That means absolutely nobody under the age of 12 is allowed inside the event area during the LAN . . . there is just too much hardware around, and not enough time that we can spend chasing them around. It is a rule of the LAN and also a rule I believe in. It is for the safety of yourself, your equipment, and especially your children (accidents do happen).
7. No weapons will be allowed inside the event area (knives, guns, grenades, picks, axe, chain gun, rocket launcher, phasers, super shotguns, and especially by all means DO NOT BRING A RAILGUN!).
